Call for SYMPOSIA and SATELLITE PROPOSALS: The Program Committee is soliciting proposals for symposia and satellites for the 2013 Annual Meeting of the International Behavioral Neuroscience Society to be held at the Grand Hotel, Malahide, County Dublin, Ireland, June 25-30. A typical symposium includes four speakers and is scheduled for two hours. Proposals should include: 1) a title, 2) the name of the chairperson(s), 3) a substantive description of the topic and proposed talks, 4) the list of speakers, their affiliations, and 5) tentative titles of their talks. Satellites are structured and financed by the organizers, prior to or after the IBNS meeting dates. For satellite proposals include the above and anticipated location and financing plans. All proposals are reviewed by the Program Committee and then submitted to the IBNS Council for consideration.

Deadline for **priority** consideration of symposium proposals was September 12, 2012. Due to considerable interest in this meeting, the **deadline** has been **extended** until **Friday, October 26, 2012**, to allow additional time to complete and submit the proposals.
